**Whereas:** The following changes regarding the responsibilities of the ICC Senator are to be updated to better fit the needs of the campus and community that the senator represents. These changes plan to provide more ways for the ICC Senator to serve as the bridge and communication between clubs of Mt. San Antonio College, and its students.

**Whereas:** Line #1 "Serve as a member of the A.S. Activities Committee" This is an outdated practice; as the role of participating the committee is not within the scope of Inter Club Council regarding clubs and students communication.

**Whereas:** Line #2 "Serve as the liaison between A.S. and ICC • Attend all ICC meetings and give a written, posted, and oral report each week regarding the activities and projects of the A.S." These lines will change to "providing reports about each organization" which serves equity for each party not only Associate's Students but also the stakes amongst different clubs, embracing the diversity this college holds.

**Whereas:** Line #3 "Assist in ICC programs and activities (i.e. ICC informational workshops, Advisor Appreciation, Join-a-Club, Marketplace)" is updated to "planning their events" which presents a simple yet clearer role of responsibility serving as the senator under Inter Club Council.

**Whereas:** Line #4 "Report back to Senate weekly regarding the activities and events of ICC" is redundant as it aligns with the updated line #3.

**Whereas:** Line #5 "Participate in the planning and implementation of at least one joint A.S. and ICC event each semester" is redundant as it aligns with the updated line #3.

**Whereas:** The line "Assist RSCOs with legislation guidance" is added as a replacement which instead further explains the responsibility to communicate, provide

extensive guidance and to coordinate with the RSCOs as a member of the Inter Club Council.

**Whereas:** By making these adjustments, the ICC Senator's responsibilities provide more clarity to what actions they need to take to fulfill their duty to the best of their ability.
