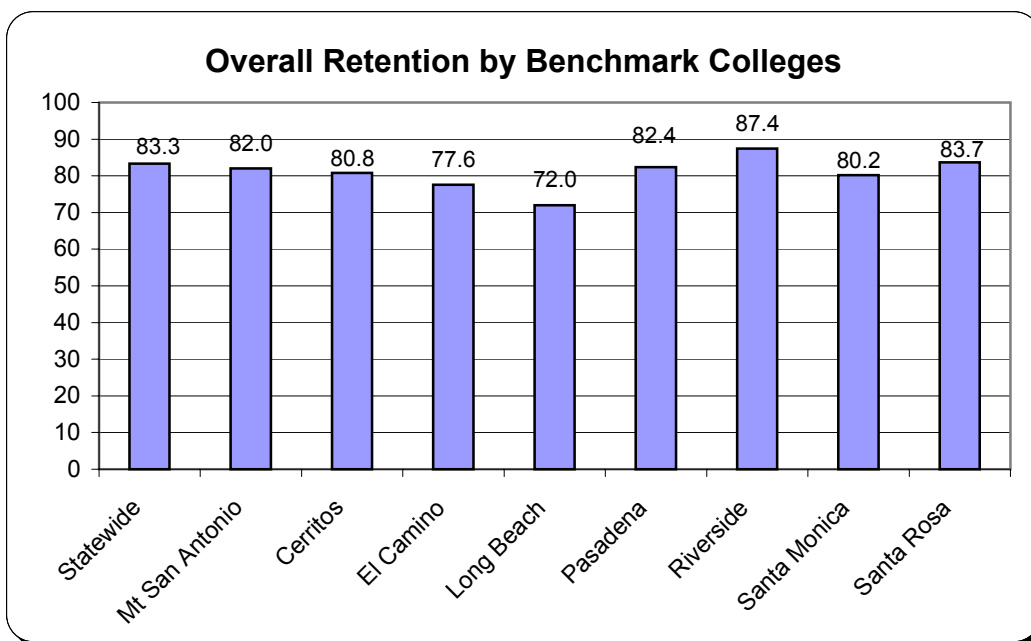


**Mt. San Antonio College
Retention Comparison by Ethnicity
Fall 2006**

Retention refers to those students who have stayed in the course beyond the add/drop date.

In Fall 2006, the retention rate for Mt. SAC was slightly below the statewide average.

Mt. SAC has a higher retention rate than most of the benchmark colleges.
