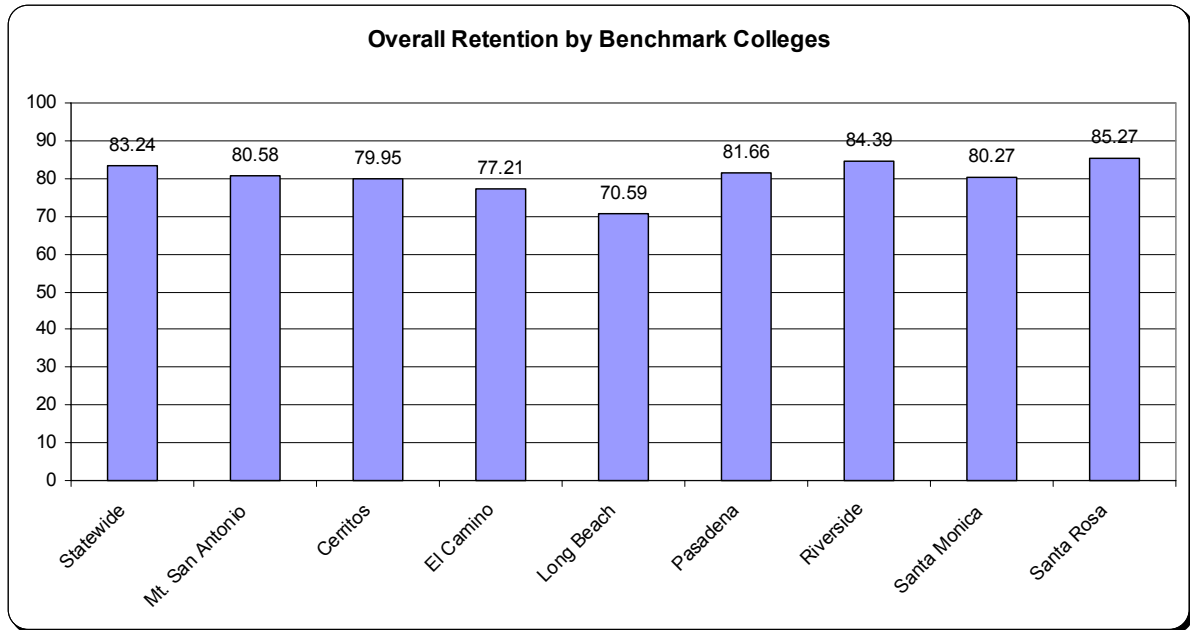


**Mt. San Antonio College
Retention Comparison by Ethnicity
Spring 2007**

Retention refers to those students who have stayed in the course beyond the add/drop rate.

In Spring 2007, the retention rate for Mt. SAC was slightly below the statewide average.

Mt. SAC's retention rate is higher than four of the seven other benchmark colleges.
