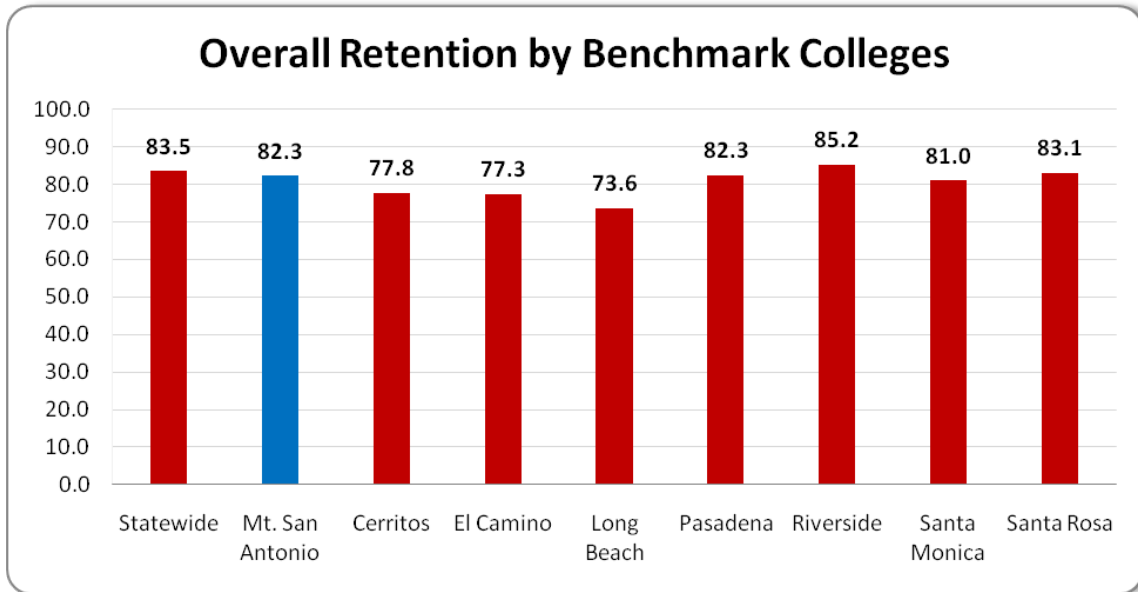


**Mt. San Antonio College  
Retention Comparison by Ethnicity  
Fall 2007**

**Retention** refers to those students who have stayed in the course beyond the add/drop rate.

In fall 2007, the retention rate for Mt. SAC was slightly below the statewide average.

Mt. SAC's retention rate is higher than four of the seven other benchmark colleges.
