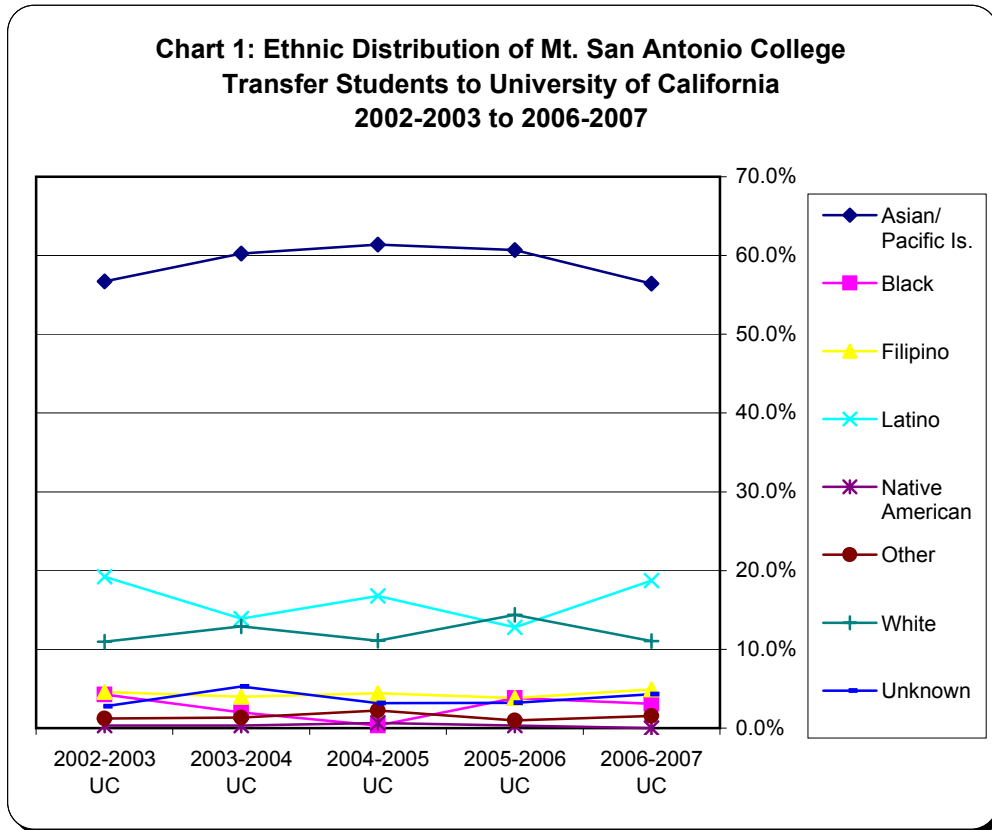

Years 2002-2003 to 2006-2007**

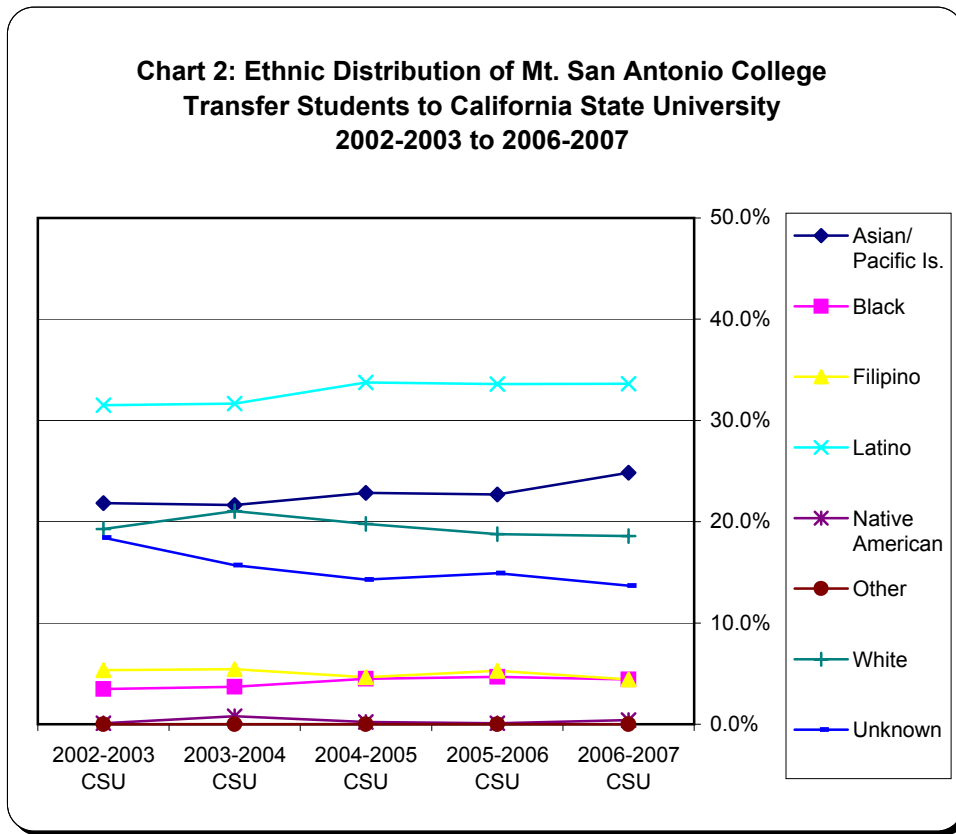

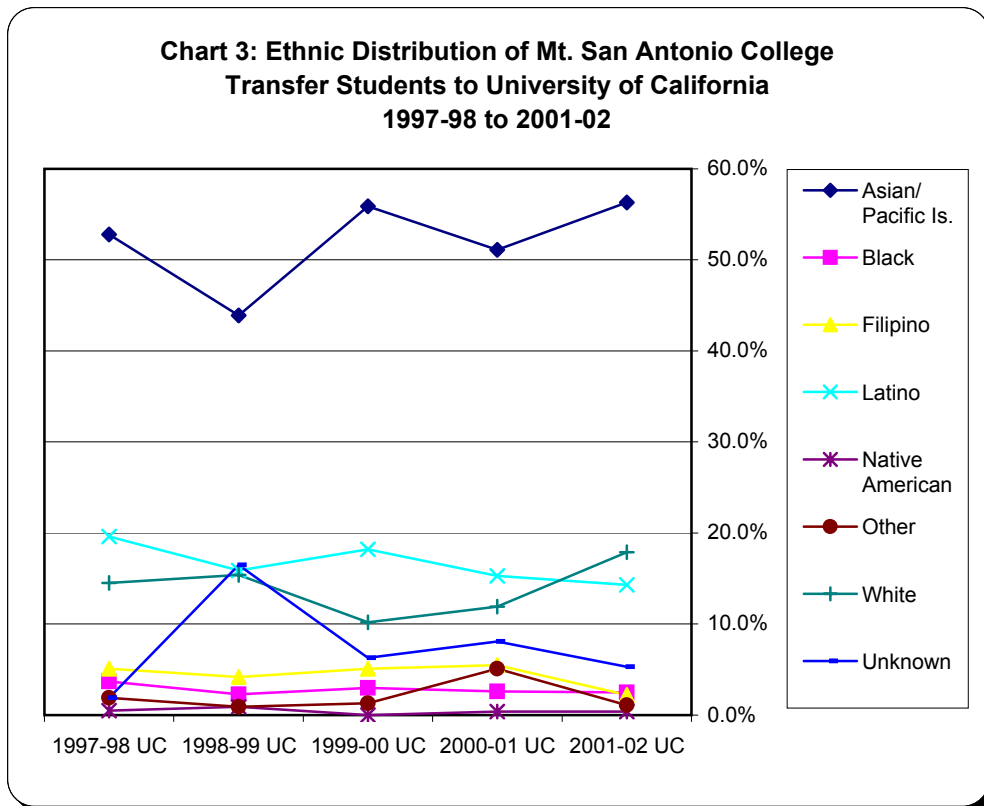

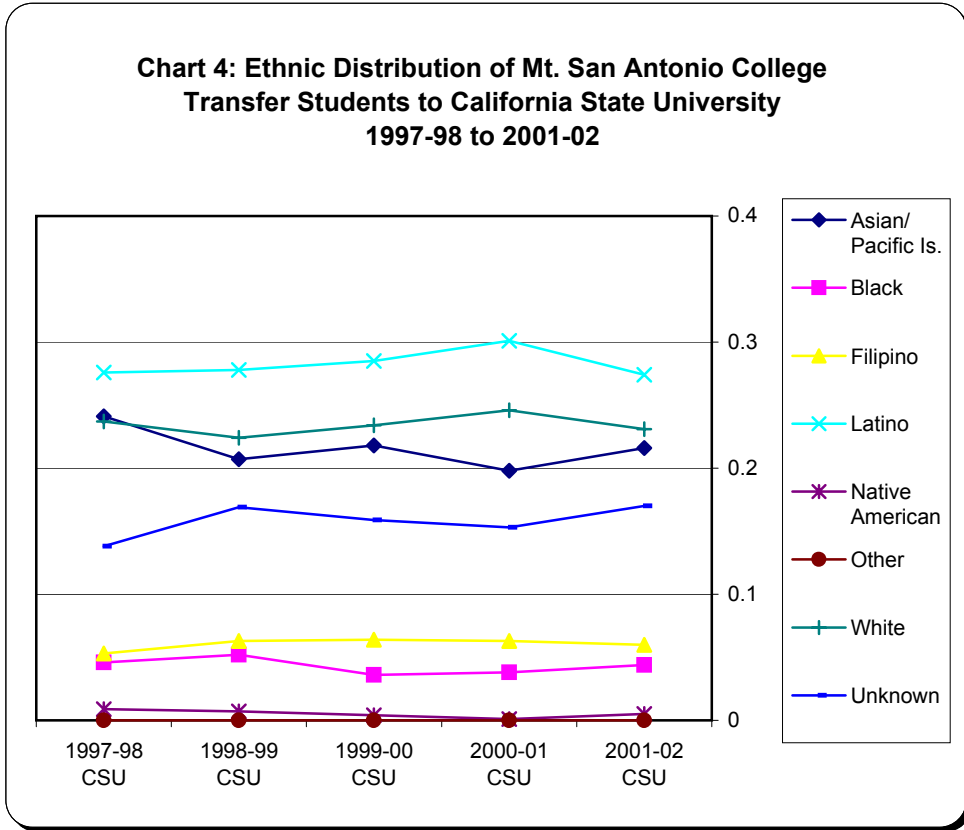

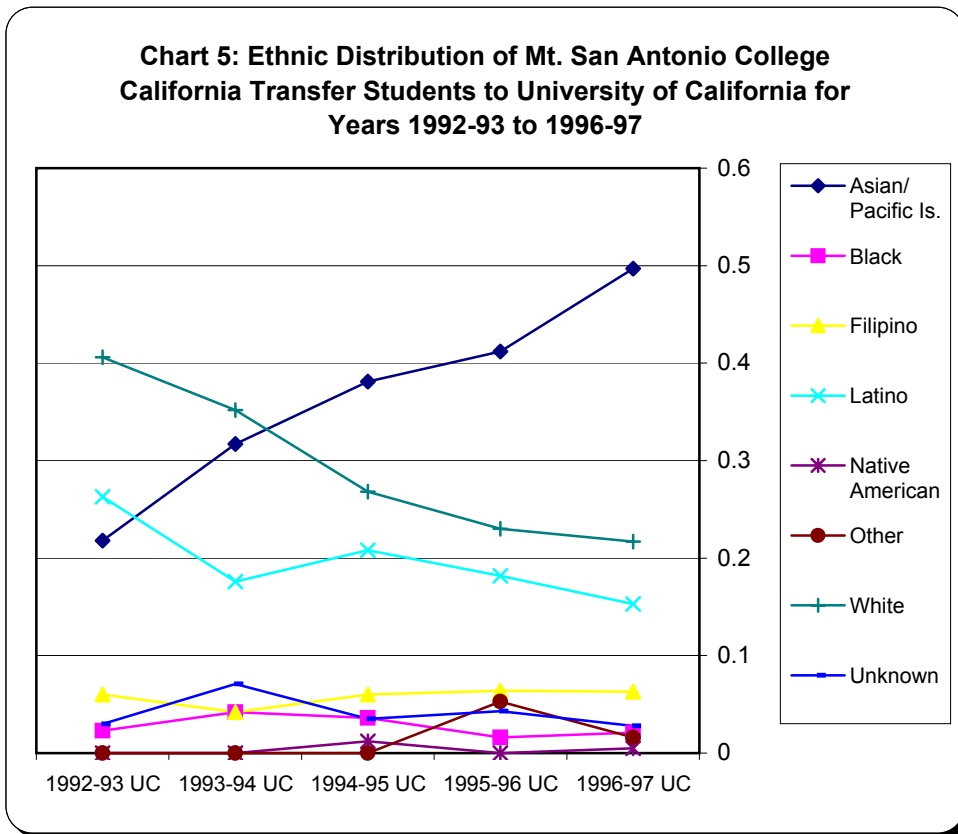

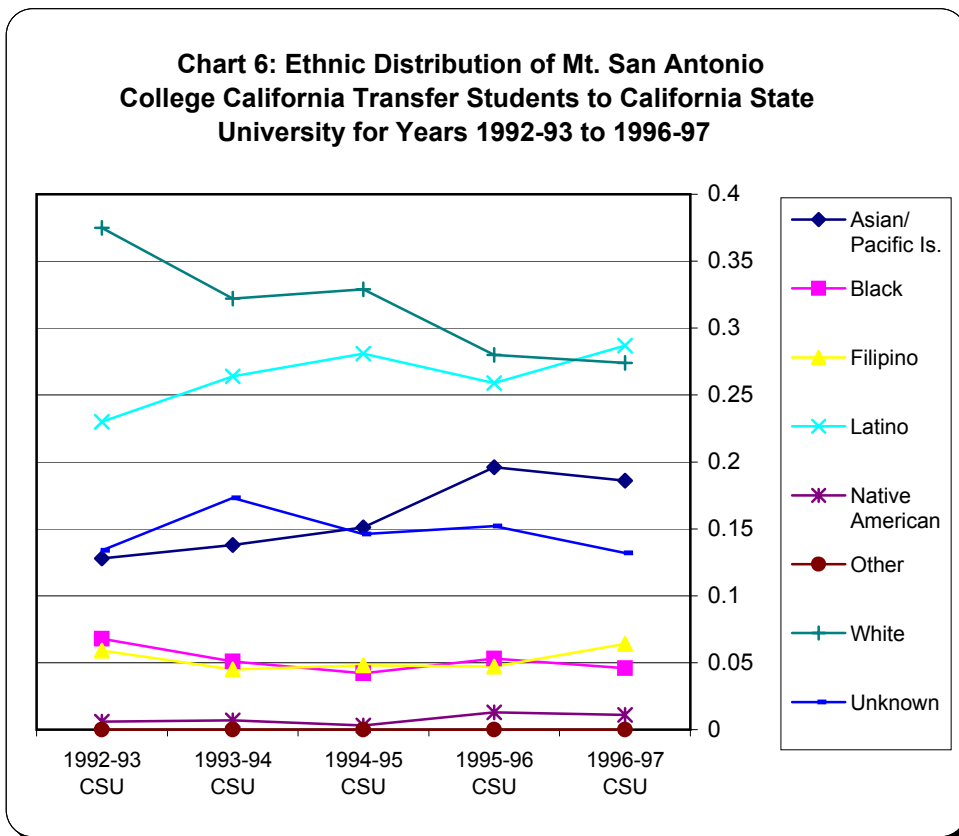

Asian/Pacific Islanders were the fastest growing ethnic group among the students who transferred from Mt. SAC to the University of California during 1992-93 to 1996-97. In fact, the percent of Asian/Pacific Islanders more than doubled from 22% to 50% during this time. Whites and Latinos were the second and third largest groups to transfer to the University of California system during the same period.

During 1992-93 and 1996-97, White students started as the largest ethnic group among the students who transferred from Mt. SAC to the California State University but descended gradually and fell behind Latinos in 1996-97. Latinos were the second largest group for four years and became the largest by the end of this period. Asian/Pacific Islanders were the third largest groups to transfer to the California State University system during the same period.
