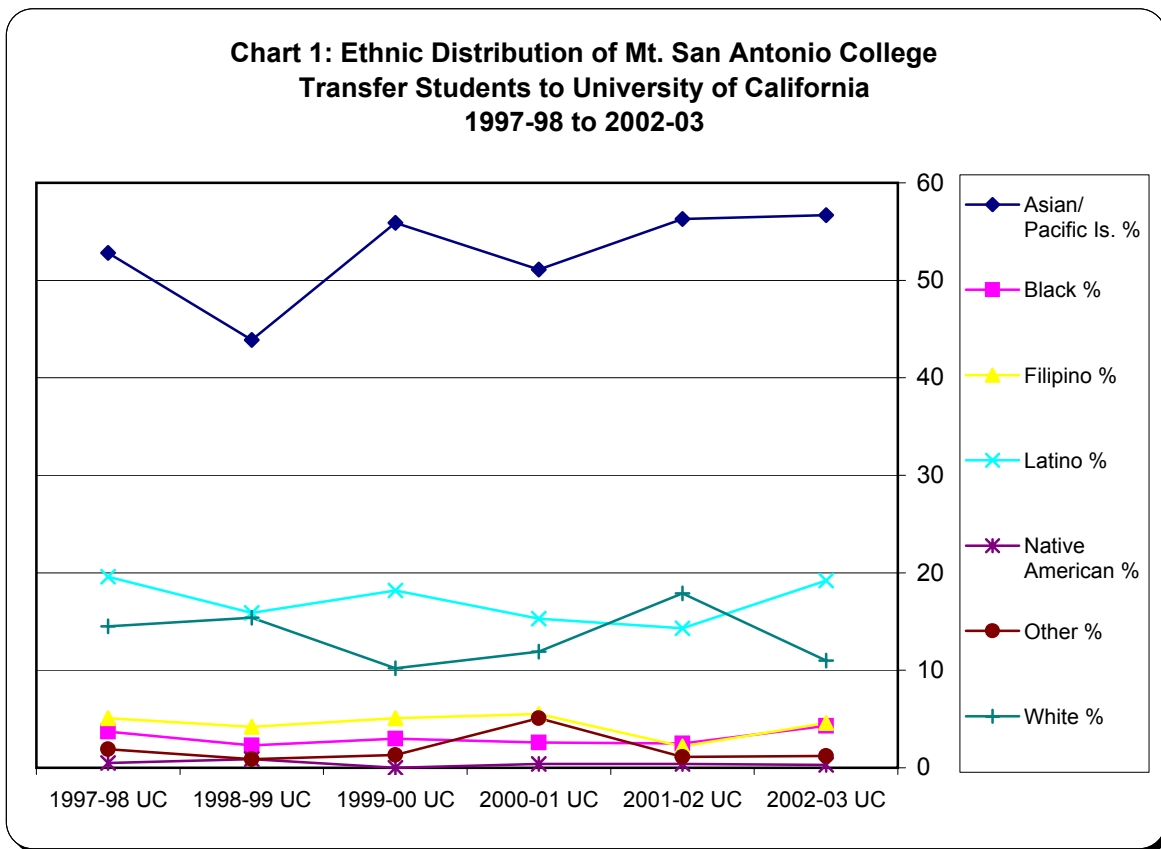

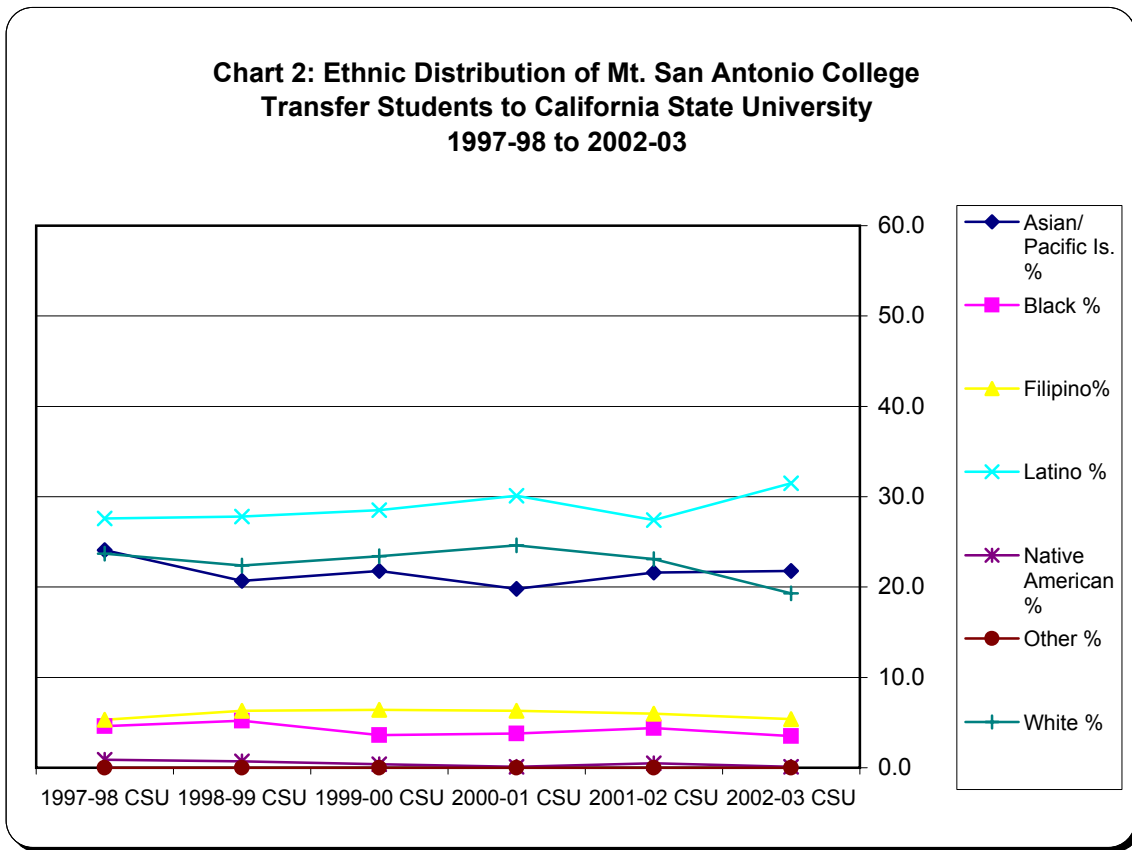

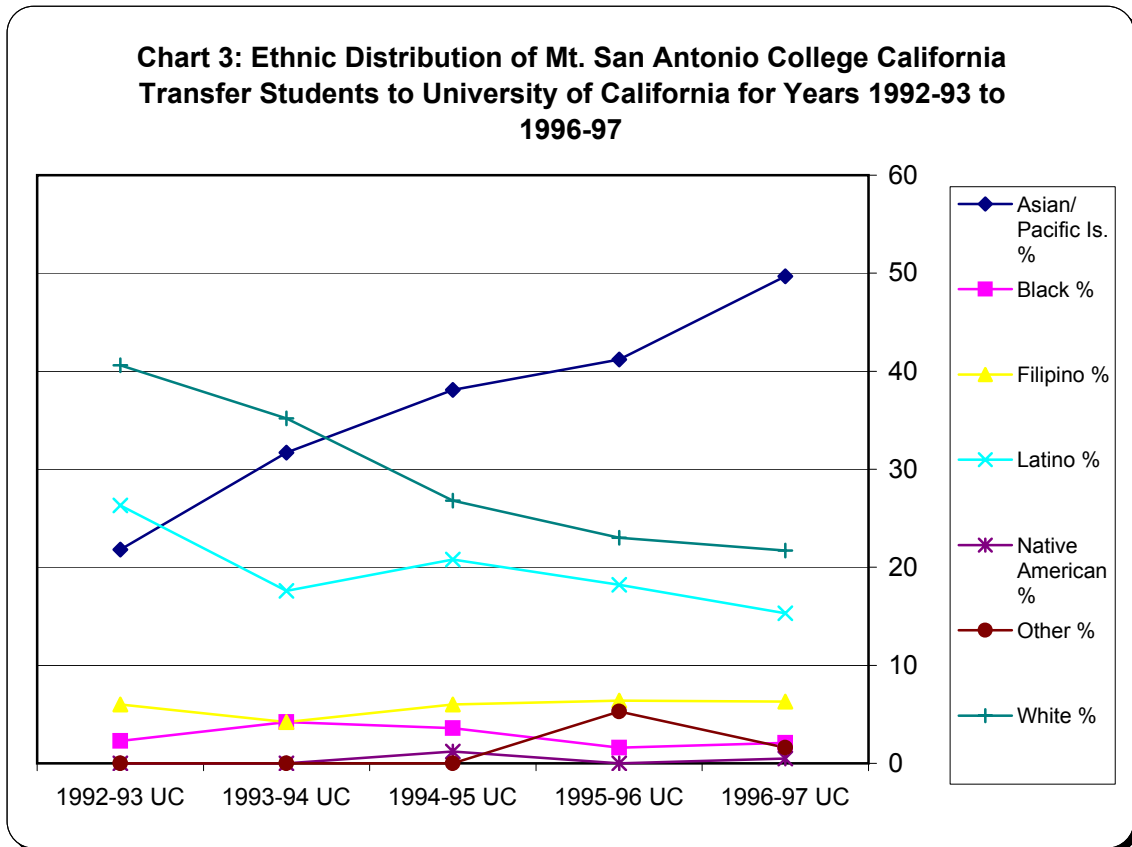

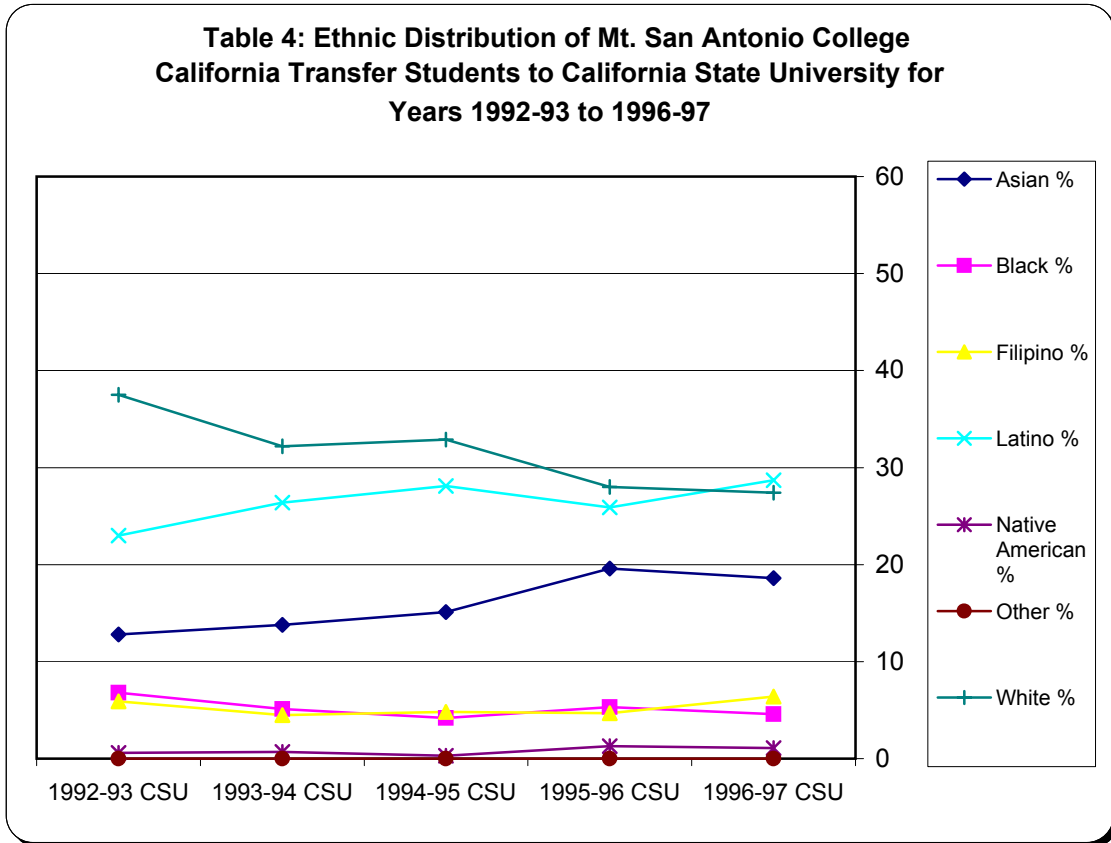


Asian/Pacific Islanders were the largest ethnic group among the students who transferred from Mt. SAC to the University of California during 1992-93 to 1996-97. In fact, the percent of Asian/Pacific Islanders more than doubled from 22% to 50% during this time. Whites and Latinos were the second and third largest groups to transfer to the University of California system during the same period.
