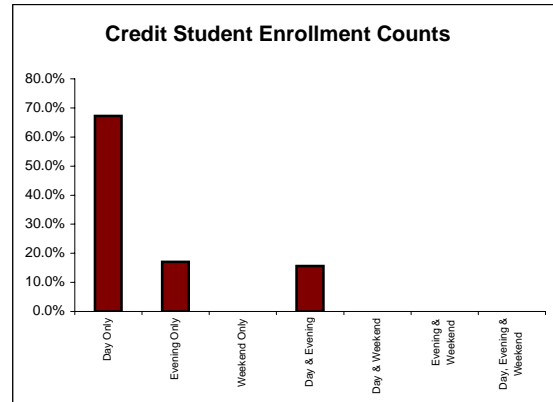

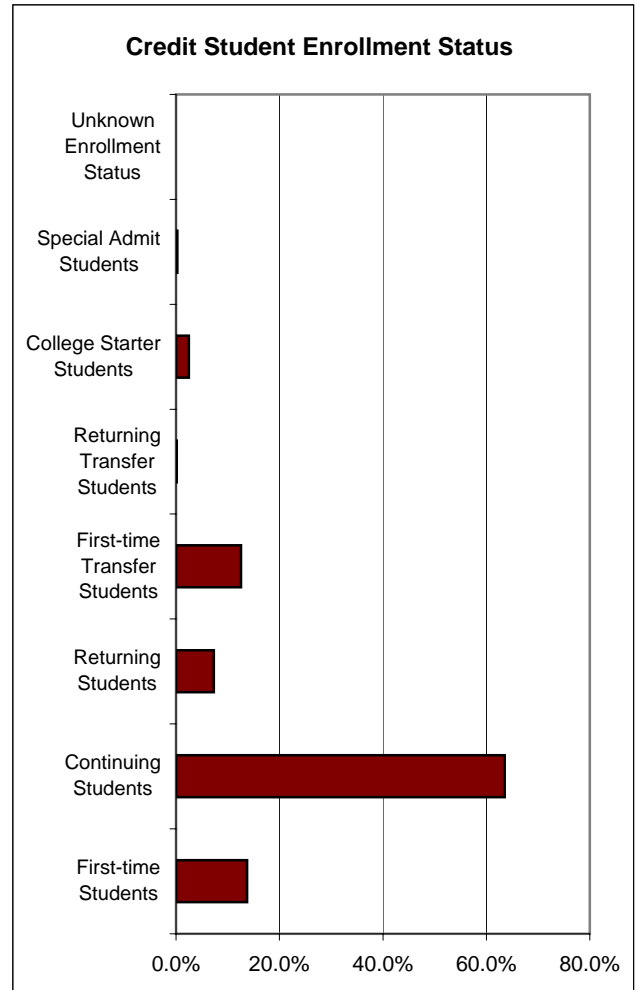

College Starter Students are high-school juniors and seniors who are attending Mt. SAC. **Special Admit Students** are students enrolled in kindergarten through tenth grade and attending Mt. SAC. Both are admitted to Mt. SAC on an individual basis by submitting a special College Starter Application.



There are many valid ways of calculating these numbers. Data in this report were calculated as of 9/13/2008 for a 9/12/2008 enrollment date using the STS907B0 Report.

* **End-of-Term** - End-of-Term data is the latest reasonable measurement Mt. SAC uses to analyze its student body. The date used for this report falls well after the actual end-date of the term. This is to allow for changes in enrollment due to grade changes, incomplete grades, etc. It is for this reason that the Office of Research and Institutional Effectiveness uses this late date as its final measurement of student enrollment at the College.

** **Unduplicated Enrollment Counts** - As of Summer 2007, the College computer system has changed. It can no longer report out Community Services fee-based data because this data is now stored in a separate computer system. Previous reports of this kind provided a detailed breakout of the unduplicated enrollment total, which it can no longer provide.
