

Intermediate Algebra—Title 5 Compliance
Resolution 2007-13

Whereas, the Academic Senate is the organization whose primary function is to make recommendations with respect to academic and professional matters (Title 5, 53200) and is primarily relied upon for curriculum and instruction, for student preparation and success, and for degree and certificate requirements (Board Policy 3255);

Whereas the Title 5 regulations effective Fall 2009 have been changed to include Intermediate Algebra as a minimum requirement for all Associate degrees;

Whereas, the Curriculum and Instruction Council is the body that makes academic recommendations related to degree and general education requirements;

Resolved, the Academic Senate directs the Curriculum and Instruction Council to ensure that the minimum of Intermediate Algebra or equivalent is included on all degrees effective Fall 2008;

Resolved, the Academic Senate directs the Curriculum and Instruction Council to make appropriate changes to catalog language to match the Intermediate Algebra requirement;

Resolved, the Academic Senate directs the Curriculum and Instruction Council to send the catalog language to the full Senate for approval before April 1, 2008.
