Child Development Strong Workforce Initiative Mt. SAC Student Application

The Strong Workforce Initiative (SWI) Child Development Internship is a new program that provides a formal educational pathway paired with on-the-job training at the Mt. SAC Child Development Center. Students must be employed at the Mt. SAC Child Development Center and enrolled in a minimum of 6 units in fall and spring semesters leading towards the completion of Child Development AS or AS-T or an Educational Paraprofessional AS.

Students engage in supportive mentoring, training, coaching and professional development which is essential for preparing emerging professionals for the early childhood workforce. Students develop crucial workplace competencies through systematic evaluation regarding family and community engagement, dual-language development, early classroom environments, special needs and inclusion, screening and assessment, leadership and professionalism.

Students gain the education and skills necessary to attain employment at partner school districts and/or government funded early childhood agencies in desirable, higher wage advanced positions as lead teachers, assistant directors, family outreach professionals, program coordinators, directors or trainers. Government funded Child Development programs provide livable wages and benefits for employees as well as many opportunities for advancement.

Students will qualify and apply for a State of California Child Development Teacher Permit or higher.

The following services are available to SWI participants:

- Weekly one-on-one coaching and support from a CDC specialist
- o Help with child development permit applications
- o Workshops on current topics and trends in the field of Child Development
- \$800 student aid for core members (\$400 stipend issued after completion of fall and spring semesters)
