

QUALIFICATIONS: CHILD DEVELOPMENT STRONG WORKFORCE

Mt. SAC Child Development Department administers Career Technical Education (CTE) to prepare professional educators with the knowledge, competencies and skills necessary for successful work in the field of Child Development. Strong Workforce provides a formal educational pathway paired with on-the-job training to student employees at the Mt. SAC Child Development Center who are working towards completing a Child Development certificate and/or a degree and are emerging Early Care and Education professionals.

Participant

To qualify as a "Participant", you must have:

- ➔ An interest in Child Development
- ➔ Completed or be currently enrolled in 2 or more core Child Development classes (CHLD 1, CHLD 5, CHLD 6, or CHLD 11)
- ➔ Current employment at the Mt. SAC Child Development Center as a student worker

Jr. Associate

To qualify as a "Jr. Associate", you must have:

- ➔ Declared Child Development or Education as your major
- ➔ Completed 3 core Child Development classes with a "C" or better: (CHLD 1, CHLD 5, CHLD 6, or CHLD 11)
- ➔ Current enrollment in 6 or more CD or GE units leading towards the completion of CD certificate, permit, degree or transfer
- ➔ An overall GPA of 2.0 or higher
- ➔ Current employment at the Mt. SAC Child Development Center as a Jr. Associate Teacher

Associate

To qualify as an "Associate", you must have:

- ➔ Declared Child Development or Education as your major
- ➔ Completed 4 core Child Development classes with a "C" or better: (CHLD 1, CHLD 5, CHLD 6, CHLD 11)
- ➔ Current enrollment in 6 or more CD or GE units leading towards the completion of CD certificate, permit, degree or transfer (or completed AS or AS-T)
- ➔ An overall GPA of 2.0 or higher
- ➔ Current employment at the Mt. SAC Child Development Center as an Associate Teacher
