Application of Goal 2: Student Learning

Improve student learning through continual development, implementation and assessment of Student Learning Goals and Outcomes.

Realign each course level SLO to only one SLG: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lianne will provide Program leaders with a list of course level SLOs currently connected to more than 1 SLG • Instructors will choose SLG most strongly aligned with SLO • TracDat will be updated to reflect only one SLG per SLO 	January 2010 January – February 2010 January – February 2010
SLG Indicators will be incorporated into TracDat at the Program level <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Course level SLO's will become the measurements of SLG indicators 	Ongoing
Student achievement of the SLGs will be measured through the SLO assessment cycle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each course level SLO will be measured at least once every 3 years • The Summary of Data for each course level SLO will report: "Criteria Met" or "Criteria Not Met". This data will be used to determine implementation effectiveness of SLGs • Summary of Data results will be annually aggregated and analyzed by Program and Division. Results will be used in the decision-making process 	Three year Assessment cycle
