



# Continuing Education Division Fast Facts 2012-13

- The Mt. SAC Continuing Education Division (CED) is the 4<sup>th</sup> largest noncredit program in California Community Colleges
- CED was established in 1971
- In 2012-13 CED generated 5,468 Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTES) hours
- CED holds a dual accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACCJC and ACS)
- CED programs serve students across the lifespan including adult learners, minors, and senior citizens
- Noncredit courses are offered four terms per year (winter, spring, summer, fall) with weekend and evening options available
- CED student support facilities include the Language Learning Center, WIN student athlete support center, ABE Career Center, ESL Library, Language SMART lab, as well as multiple on-campus and off-campus computer labs (ABE, ESL, EOA)
- Classes are available on the Mt. SAC campus and at over 50 community-based sites such as senior and community centers
- Programs that focus on career development and college preparation (CDCP) show a matriculation rate to credit of 19%
- CED counselors and educational advisors held 4,442 individual student appointments in 2012-13
- Fee-based classes and programs include Career and Professional Development, Driver Education, Personal Enrichment, Sports and Fitness, Children and Teens, and Online Learning
- Community Education (fee-based) and Contract Training had 8,263 enrollment transactions in 2012-13
