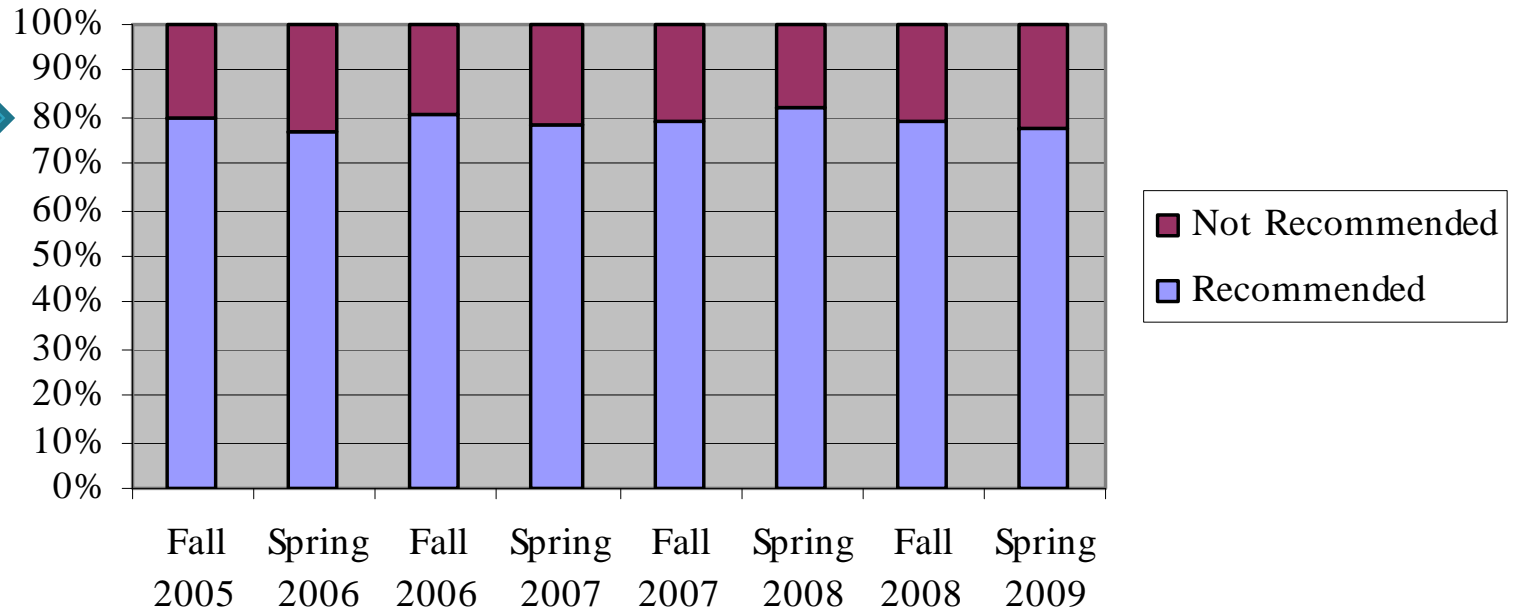

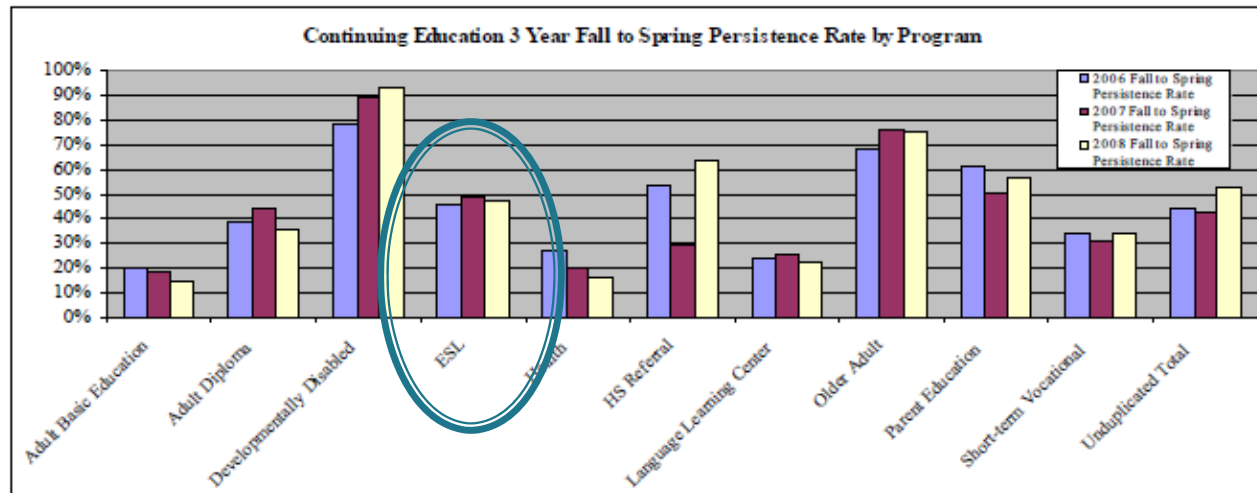

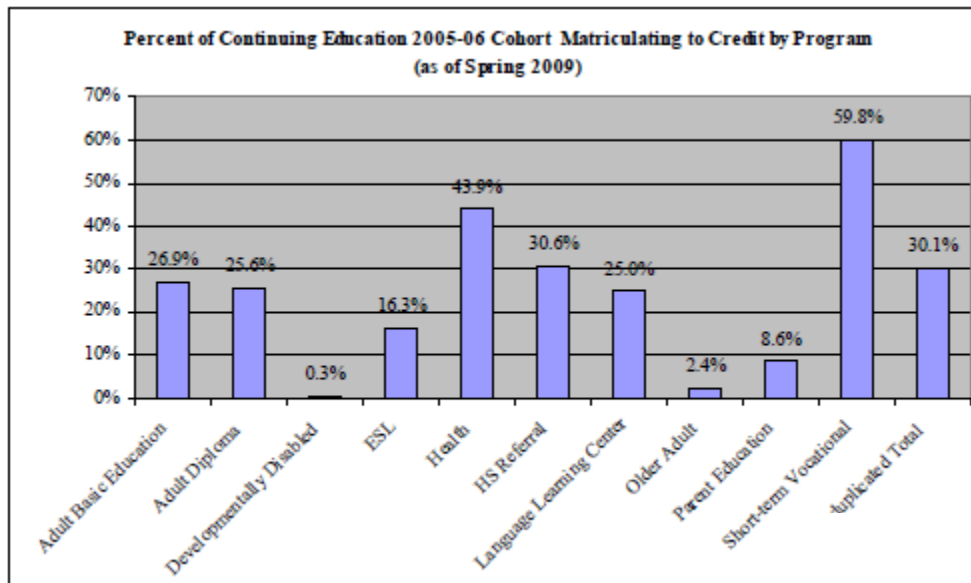

Overall

- ▶ Our CASAS results at every level are beyond the state average.
 - ▶ Our CASAS Benchmarks have been climbing since 2006.
 - ▶ Our EL Civics Pay Points increased steadily from 2005–2008, but went down slightly in 2009.
 - ▶ A few more students are progressing through our program from 2005–2009.
 - ▶ Currently 16% of our students go on to credit classes at Mt. SAC.
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
