

**Foundation Support for Campus Programs
Resolution 2011-11**

Whereas, the Academic Senate is the organization whose primary function is to make recommendations with respect to academic and professional matters as defined in Title 5, Article 2, Section 53200; and,

Whereas, the Mt. San Antonio College Foundation has a long history of providing significant resources to students in the form of scholarships; and,

Whereas, the Foundation has recently indicated an interest in providing financial support directly to College instructional programs; and,

Whereas, the Foundation has asked for increased faculty support of its fundraising efforts and for faculty input into the process of how funds could be allocated to instructional programs;

Resolved, that the Academic Senate recommends that Mt. San Antonio College develop a campus-wide Foundation Advisory Committee, whose purpose would be to identify and prioritize instructional program needs for potential Foundation financial support; and,

Resolved, that the Academic Senate recommends and encourages individual faculty to support actively the Foundation's fund raising efforts on behalf of instructional programs and support services; and,

Resolved, that the Academic Senate recommends and encourages faculty to alert the Foundation to potential donor opportunities to which they may become aware.
