Purpose

Function

- 1. Review services available to students in areas of housing, food, wellness, hygiene, and transportation, and explore ways to fill these gaps.
- 2. Recommend ways that individuals/offices can coordinate work related to issues of housing, food, wellness, hygiene, transportation, outreach, and marketing related to informing students of these resources.
- 3. Recommend updates to the College website/portal to include links to services available on-campus as well as to community-based resources relating to housing, food, wellness, hygiene, and transportation.
- 4. Liaise with Professional and Organizational Development (POD) to educate College faculty and staff on ways to sensitively and effectively address issues related to housing, food, wellness, hygiene, and transportation.
- 5. Explore ways to create partnerships with businesses, as well as public and private agencies, in the College's catchment area to supply resources for students in need.
