New Resources Allocation Positions Authorized But Not Filled	 President's Cabinet requested this report to review positions that were authorized but not filled. Rosa explained that Cabinet has made several decisions to continue funding or stop the funding. The decision details can be found in the report titled "Summary of Decisions Made at President's Cabinet March 14 & March 21, 2017." Gary was concerned about the removal of \$780,000 funds for project managers. He would like to know, what was the criteria used for the removal of these budgets? 	Gary will send an email to Mike, as Chair of the Budget Committee, addressing his concerns with the changes. Once the emails are received from Grace and Gary, Mike will share the concerns with Dr. Scroggins.
Summary of Decisions Made at President's Cabinet March 14 & March 21, 2017	 The first column "Removed from Funding" shows the items that President's Cabinet has decided to remove. Budget for project managers and four positions have been removed from one-time funding, totaling \$1,193,696. The second column "Funded with Unrestricted General Fund Ongoing" shows the College will be funding 2.3 FTEs in new Faculty positions with ongoing funds for \$146,842. This amount is net of the deduction for hourly faculty backfill. The amount listed, (\$151,467), is for the Title IX manager that was originally funded with ongoing funds. This funding was decreased because the existing ongoing funds for investigations/legal 	ocroggins.
