2. Review the Budget Committee Meeting Summary of May 20, 2020	The Budget Committee Meeting Summary of May 20, 2020, was reviewed and approved.	Meeting summary approved.	
3. State Budget Update	<ul> <li>Morris Rodrigue provided the State Budget Update:</li> <li>Differences between the Governor's and Senate Proposals were discussed.</li> <li>The Senate's proposal rejects many of the Governor's May Revision proposed cuts, including the reduction of Proposition 98 funding.</li> <li>Absent federal funding, one of the Senate proposals is to defer approximately \$1 billion in community college funding necessarily if the Heroes Act comes through, but rather continue it and then defer.</li> <li>The deferral impacts colleges that receive less in Property Tax, which will impact Mt. San Antonio College because the state funding is larger.</li> </ul>	Accreditation Standard IIID. On June 4 <sup>th</sup> the Assembly Budget Committee is expected to release and approve its 2020-21 budget plan which will be presented for a full assembly vote.	
4. 2019-20 Tentative Budget Update	<ul> <li>Cabinet is currently discussing hiring "frost" which only limits hiring and filling of vacant positions will be authorized.</li> </ul>	Accreditation Standard IIID.	

<ul> <li>Budget and expenditure analysis of 3-year data has been sent out to all managers.</li> <li>Vice Presidents are reviewing the New Resource Allocations and looking at the Carry-Over budgets.</li> <li>Morris may be making a recommendation to the Board not to deposit into the OPEB Trust this year.</li> </ul>	Will review the tentative budget on the June 17 <sup>th</sup> meeting.
