This course appears to create a deep dive into Italian culture. However, it does not sociological, physiological, and psychological inquiry of the person. It is not recommended as an appropriate course for GE Area E.
PSYC 26	Psychology of Sexuality	D – Social Sciences	Area D Social Sciences – The course does not lead to a broader understanding of the principles, methodologies, value systems, and ethics employed in social scientific inquiry. No social scientific inquiry or focus on concepts and methods of the social science discipline.
SOC 36	Asian American Communities	D – Social Sciences	Area D Social Sciences – The course does not appear to lead to a broader understanding of the principles, methodologies, value systems, and ethics employed in social scientific inquiry. Need more detail in course content on how students learn to practice social science and not just understand what social scientists have concluded.
