Pass/No P	ass – J. Fowler		If we remove the limit on P/NP grading, there is a concern about students who decide to go to a CSU or UC which may have a top limit of Pass/No Pass courses.
			One immediate solution is to have faculty members consider the grading option they are choosing. This can be verified during prescreening.
			A long-term option is to require faculty members to select the grading option and provide some rationale for the selection if P/NP is being selected as required.
			There is no way to alert students using Map P/NP courses they are taking and there is no way to program MAP to accommodate students who change their mind about the grading option.
