OEI Update (Meghan)	<ul> <li>Spring 2018 was the launch of the Online Course Exchange.</li> <li>Summary: <ul> <li>14 students attempted to enroll through the Course Exchange software.</li> <li>Of those, 10 got through the process.</li> <li>Of the 10 students, 9 are taking classes at LTCC, 1 at Mt. SAC (GEOG 1).</li> <li>Of the 14 total, 2 dropped after enrolling and paying for their classes.</li> <li>Participation in the Course Exchange moved</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>students forward in achieving their educational goals. Some examples:</li> <li>- 4 needed the class(es) offered at LTCC in order to graduate or transfer at the end of this semester.</li> <li>These are courses that Mt. SAC does not offer fully online: POLS 100 and MATH 110.</li> <li>- 2 students maxed out on their repeats for ENGL 1A at Mt. SAC.
