	 http://www.mtsac.edu/distancelearning/ to better inform students. Michelle had some recommendations about improving the page which she will discuss with Hugo. Another suggestion was to separate the Student Resources from Staff & Faculty resources.
	 Portal - work on a better way to inform students about DL/online courses.
	 Distance Learning vs. Online - which term is recognized by students? The majority think students relate better to the term "online".
	• Schedule of Classes - It is pretty easy to search for Distance Learning Classes via the filter box provided they understand the term "distance learning". However, when viewing the schedule the term "Arrange X hours" may be confusing to students. The term "Arrange Hours" is also on work experience classes and activity classes like Kinesiology.
	 Counseling - promoting online is not part of their standard orientation curriculum but may be mentioned in some sessions.
	The discussion theme was on marketing so that we
	may capture those students who are not aware of DL class offerings or need help filtering the Schedule of Classes to locate DL offerings.
