I.	Welcome and Land Acknowledgement – Shiloh Blacksher	I would like to take a moment to acknowledge that Mt. III.	Announcements	The catalog links to the GPS maps were broken and had to be fixed. This is an ongoing issue and those links have to be repaired multiple times a year. We are working with the vendor to embed the maps in the catalog pages as a separate tab on the catalog program pages. There was a script issue within the GPS maps. The "or" and "and" options and units were missing. A fix was implemented, and this issue has been resolved. There is another script error where units were missing on about 20 program maps. This is being investigated. It may be a data transfer issue from DegreeWorks.		
IV.	Career Cluster Academic Programs and Process — Patricia Maestro	Career Clusters or meta majors were created about 5 years ago in collaboration with faculty and students. Mt. SAC programs were then placed into these Career Clusters. The Clusters were aligned with Holland Codes, which were being used by counseling faculty in regards to career development with students. Programs were placed into the Career Clusters by two experienced counselors. We need a process to place programs into these areas. Career counselors will meet to suggest a process to collaborate with program faculty and bring Career Cluster placement recommendations through the Mapping and Catalog Committee.		

		An introduction to the Career Cards page and the process might help students and faculty understand the creation and placement of programs into these clusters.
