- A. Website Update
 - 1. OC website is now in the same format as other campus committees
 - 2. It will have a link to the older contents of previous website.
- B. Survey at Print Shop
 - 1. 119 responded = 62 adjuncts, 41 full-time faculty, 11 staff, 5 students
 - 2. They were from all divisions
 - 3. 63% full-time faculty and 40% adjuncts do not understand the benefits of SLOs
 - 4. Many want a clear explanation of the process and the purpose of SLOs
