"Overall" GPA might mean unweighted?

Maria: Need popup with FAQ to help students that don't have counselors helping them.

Call Admissions if can't enroll in course that should be eligible for.

Eventually, #14 will populate new eligibility.

IT will create Assessment Questionnaire portlet. Put on top of Student Success tab. Rename SSI.

Message to current students: You're a continuing student, you have assessed. Now you have an opportunity to assess with our new process.

Added "Current Mt. SAC student, not attending High School". This should take to students to same place as "Earned HS diploma..."

Have you taken English/math in college? Change options to something like this:

- "No I did not take any English or math course(s) in college"
- "Yes I took English but not math in college"
- "Yes I took math but not English in college"
- "Yes I took both English and math in college"

Change question to "Which years of high school did you complete in the United States?"

Change "all" to caps "ALL" in for "(check all that apply)"

Change to "Please select the highest math course in which you are currently enrolled" (if possible, insert help box: "The math courses listed are in order from lowest to highest.")

??? Help box for first question. "If you are a dual enrollment student, please select "Attending High School"."

English: "English (includes AP/IB/Honors, Lit, Non-ESL)"

Add help box for unweighted GPA. Q: Is "Overall GPA" unweighted if they don't have unweighted spelled out?

Antonio: Video of International student answering them, Continuing student, New student answer, Reentry student, filling out Assessment Questionnaire.

Jim: Watch video before take Assessment Questionnaire. Pick student that best suits what you are.
