English Language <br> System (ELS) <br> Educational Services <br> Articulation with <br> AMLA | D Grosch introduced the ELS curriculum in order for the <br> committee to discuss the possibility of entering into an MOU <br> that permits students to enter Mt. SAC without having to <br> take TOEFL or IELTS. There is a long list of colleges that <br> currently accept Level 109 into their colleges. | The Committee unanimously voted to <br> accept ELS level 109 for entrance into <br> Mt.SAC without TOEFL or IELTS <br> testing. |
| 3. Rubric Development | There has been a change to the AWE rubric which <br> specifically affects placement into English 1A/80 and English <br> 1A. The Committee recommends that a note be placed onto <br> the student's placement results page if the AWE writing <br> sample received two minus scores. Two minus scores will <br> trigger a flag which means that the paper doesn't meet the <br> threshold for AMLA 1A./80.
