1. Minutes	Minutes from May 9, 2018	Approved as amended
	Everyone enjoyed sandwiches, berries and drinks. J Ocampo commended this committee for working so hard and achieving so much since November 2017. C Tran, B Heasley, A Bangloy received certificates commending their work and collaboration to design and implement a new placement system.	
2. Rubric Update	E Hill-Enriquez reported that the AWE reading training is June 14. Model anchor papers are being selected to exemplify the new placements into English 1A and English 1A/80.	
3. AQ Update	C Tran reported that AMLA 90 has been linked to the department website. There has been some discussion about whether Math should accept student self-reported geometry grades to satisfy the Math 150 geography requirement. J Ocampo mentioned that in the future we need to validate the geometry competency test when the moratorium is off	IIC

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	for test approval in Sacramento. C Tran will write a program that will send an email to students whose placement changed from Eng 67 to Eng 1A/80 or Eng 90 or Eng 68.  About 3,500 students need to receive this message so that they know about their placement change. Regarding data base testing 12C, A Bangloy informed the group that there will be a fix for the special characters that are randomly appearing.	
	J Ocampo said that there was a script that has been fixed that affects I-20 international students only. M Tsai reported that so far 5,971 students have taken the AQ for placement. A Bangloy shared that he is getting requests to share our source code for the AQ as other colleges move into adopting MM. J Ocampo shared, too, that he is getting requests from other colleges. Ours is being seen as the model.	
4.Updates	AMLA Update. E Hill-Enriquez showed a copy of the packet that AMLA presented to counselors, including the new AMLA flow chart. A Bangaloy will send an email to members to launch the SS-MM Microsoft Team, which is a centralized repository of notes and documents of this team.  Math Update. At the last AB 705 update meeting it was noted that all students will be allowed to take statistics. Students who are enrolled in Algebra II will have access to Trig and college algebra; MMAP will make this proposal soon. D Rivers noted that the initial feeling that continuing students aren't really interested in taking the AQ to replace, which is seen in the data that M Tsai passed out. D Beydler has made a Math prep session video and asks where it should be housed.	A Bangloy will talk with E Turner to see where the math prep session video should be housed to make it easy for students to access.
