New this time around is that the two- or three-year clock can begin in non-credit if the NC course feeds into English/Math. There is no widely accepted definition of what is highly unlikely to succeed in a class. No answer to that right now. It could be from 6% to 70% highly unlikely. 	Students on probation for two semesters in a row lose their BOG. If a course has a hard prerequisite, data must be collected for three years first. D Beydler has heard that highly unlikely is about 10% on average or perhaps 5-10 percent, 20-30% is the highest possible range of highly unlikely. But 40% is not highly unlikely to succeed, according to what D Beydler has been hearing.
