The deadline for student participation may need to be extended. A decision was made to have students take multiple surveys for those simultaneously enrolled in math/AmLa/reading/English courses. Bradshaw reported that IT identified the pool of students (approximately 600) who are affected by recent updated eligibility for ENGL 1A. IT is inputting updated eligibility into Banner. Communication will be sent to students once updates are made in Banner. |  |
| 4. Recommendation 53 (David) <br> a. Add Math 100 <br> (Survey of College Math) as a recommended class in the AQ for Arts \& Humanities majors. <br> b. Comment from Math 100 Committee: Remember that Math 100 is rigorous. <br> c. Counseling Department okay with recommendation? | MATH 100 (now approved for IGETC) is a valid option for Arts \& Humanities majors and will be included in AQ placement messaging for Arts \& Humanities majors. SOC 23 and PSYC 10 were also briefly discussed, but prerequisites are an issue for inclusion in the $A Q$. <br> J. Lopez confirmed that the Counseling Department agrees with accepting recommendation 53. | The Committee unanimously approved Recommendation 53. This will be taken to SPEAC for acceptance. |
