Due: March 11, 2022	Ned reported that the English Department plans to go with Option 2 (which means that no pre-transfer-level English classes starting Fall 2022). David reported that the Math Department voted to go with Option 2 (which means no pre-transfer-level math classes starting Fall 2022). However, the Math Department felt that it was important to state that the vote was made under duress due to requirements from the Chancellor's Office. Audrey shared that Dr. Scroggins would like to pursue Option 3 of the form (which would mean offering some pre-transfer-level classes in Fall 2022). Dr. Scroggins and Kelly Fowler would like to become more involved in the next steps. Maria asked if the data that we're collecting through the AQ is still relevant and helpful to placement. Is there other information we need to collect in the AQ or outside the AQ, such as information about support resources, student backgrounds, etc.? Is there anything we need to collect to help understand what students are entering our classrooms? Liza asked if we could look at surveys or data collected in the last 2 years comparing success rates for online vs. face-to-face. Ned mentioned that there are data dashboards for that, but he's not sure if they're broken down by demographics. Dana commented that one way to support students at the entry, transfer level is to link a math or English class with an ACCESS class. Only 51% of students in the main class need to be registered with ACCESS; the other students don't. Jesse shared that the New Student Orientations and MAP Workshops typically peak in May for summer registrations, and July for fall registrations. He said for the upcoming terms, we'll need to focus on students who need to retake developmental classes—they may not get a chance starting Fall 2022. Also,	OUTCOME
	we'll need to be more strategic about how to do ed planning—helping students schedule classes and balance their load.
