Reviewed minutes from the prior meeting held on October 15, 2013.

### MINUTES (Nov 19, 2013)

- **Reviewed the GEO RE-imagined report** from the October 18<sup>th</sup> session. The new, proposed competencies will focus on reconfiguring social responsibility, personal responsibility, ethical responsibility, civic and global understanding, artistic understanding, historical understanding, and cultural understanding. Each competency was also discussed. OC reviewed the perception of the different models and they are unclear about thinking of assessment.
- Jason Chevalier met with Terri Long and Michelle Grimes Hilman recently to discuss how to **imbed the SLO process in the curriculum process**. Possible options include a cover letter capturing SLO entries or use Stage 4 in WebCMS that would be needed to approve the course's SLO information. This was a good start to a discussion about how to include SLO's in curriculum development.
- **Need to update the OC Plan** to better include student services in the process. Jason Chevalier hopes to complete another draft during the early Spring semester to present to the committee and Academic Senate for approval. There will be a Qualitative Feedback Meeting held on Tuesday 11/26 from 10-11:15 am.
- **The President's awards** will be sent to the committee to review by email. The Awards info will be reviewed at the next meeting.
- A future meeting should include a review of student friendly websites. Students need a website and tool to explain the SLO process.
