- Members from the Outcomes Committee responded to interview questions from multiple members of the Accreditation Visiting Team.

Approval of Minutes:

- Minutes from the December 6, 2016 were approved.

Old Business

- Four-Year Review and Outcomes Assessment Cycles
 - Based upon the review process, course outcome assessment activities were updated in TracDat. Some courses were recommended for inactivation via the College's curriculum process.
 - 99.5% of courses have current assessment reported in TracDat.

New Business

- Outcomes Assessment and College Planning: Tabled
- Adjunct Compensation for SLO Work
 - Committee members approved requests for adjunct compensation from the following areas: Library and Learning Resources Division, Music Department, Nutrition and Foods Program, and Sociology and Philosophy Department
 - Committee members reviewed and approved a follow-up report from the Nutrition and Foods Program.

- Student SLO Project
 - Together with Associated Students, we have worked on this project for a year. We have experienced setbacks due to student and staff departures.
 - Currently we are seeking a new meeting with Student Life. We are also reaching out to the Graphic Design & Illustration Club (GRID) to develop material.

- Presidential Awards for Excellence and Innovation in Teaching and Learning
 - The Committee will seek applications for the Presidential Awards during this semester.
 - Action: All committee members are asked to review the application form and rubric and bring feedback to the next meeting.

- Outcomes Plan – three year review
 - The Outcomes Plan 2012-2020 was last reviewed in February 2014, with approval by the Academic Senate in May 2014. Per the plan, Committee members will review the plan on a three-year review cycle.
 - Action: All committee members are asked to review the Outcomes Plan and bring feedback to the next meeting.
