Old Business

- Four-Year Review and Outcomes Assessment Cycles 2016 results
 - o The committee reviewed the results of the most current four-year review cycle and discussed whether this reflects a larger problem of incomplete outcomes assessments and if this might impact our upcoming accreditation review. Potential solutions were discussed. Mary Ann Gomez-Angel asked whether Non-Credit is included in the review cycle; we'll gather that information and report back at a future meeting.

New Business

- Course Measurable Objectives and Student Learning Outcomes
 - o Discussion focused on the essential differences between CMOs and SLOs and whether it was wise to equate them. Mary Ann Gomez-Angel discussed the application of the two outcomes to Non-Credit and what that division has done with regard to training and application of assessment methods. Jonathan Hymer discussed the development of CMOs and SLOs on the Mt. SAC campus and what is the distinction between the two. It was advised that whatever direction we

take, if it is a radical departure it shouldn't happen until after the March 6 ACCJC visit—we don't want to confuse faculty with a big shift at the eleventh hour.
