Approval of Minutes: Minutes were approved for the March 21, 2017 committee meeting.

Old Business

- Outcomes Assessment and College Planning
 - o Committee members discussed the connection between outcomes assessment and college planning, including Planning for Institutional Effectiveness (PIE) and the Strategic Plan. Members noted departments struggle to tie resource requests or curriculum decisions to outcomes assessment. Departments also struggle to close the loop. Members expressed concern that connecting outcomes assessment to resource requests, and meeting ACCJC mandates related to outcomes assessment, may conflict with the overall goal for authentic assessment. Additionally, members noted that many faculty members, including adjunct and full-time, are unfamiliar with the PIE process.
 - Action: Emily and Mark will request a meeting with the Institutional Effectiveness Committee (IEC) to discuss intersections between the two committees' work.
- President's Awards for Excellence and Innovation in Teaching and Learning
 - The announcement for the President's Award was sent to the Announce-C listserv on March 23. Emily and Mark also sent the announcement directly to chairs and instruction managers.
 - The nomination deadline is April 18. If needed, the deadline can be extended one week.

- Outcomes Plan three year review
 - o Committee members began review of the Outcomes Plan, which was last approved by the Academic Senate in May 2014. Multiple changes may be necessary—in terminology and in current processes.
 - Action: Emily will share an edited version of the plan at the next committee meeting.
