2. Board of Governor's Update

Bill Rawlings reported on the following:

- His term expires Tuesday, January 14. He is still waiting on word if he will continue to serve.
- The Code of Conduct Policy is being updated.
- Fiscal independent status was granted to West Valley Mission Community College and Gavilan College.
- Grants will be reviewed.
- Voting has changed at San Joaquin Delta College.
- The president and vice president have been reelected.
- There was a first reading of the Discrimination Issues Policy
- There was discussion of Title IV regarding auxiliary foundations.
- A lot work is being done on ESL AB 85 with a first reading and a working group being developed for feedback.
- There was discussion about improving Academic Senate.
- There is a resolution for the Pre-K Bond Act.
- There has been a change to Barstow Community College's election system.
- There was a second reading of the Unlawful Discrimination Policy.
- The development of an oversight committee for Student Funding Formula will be an upcoming agenda topic.
- Discussion regarding the definition of "First Generation" is on-going.
