5. Institutional Effectiveness Committee (IEC) Report and Update

- IEC is looking at pushing out the deadline for unit PIE's to June 15 and the manager PIE's prior to August 15.
- They are also looking at decreasing the time of Faculty's task with their current challenges they are facing right now.
- A strong focus needs to be made on resource allocation, although it is difficult to project at this time with the uncertainties.
- It all depends on what we are doing in the fall.
- The discussion is about creating a document that explains our planning system and how it contributes to the overall themes that flow from our mission, vision, and core values statements.
- The discussion also includes creating broader teams for long range planning and strategic plans like PIE for year to year planning.
- The struggle is putting an organic process in the strategic plan.
- There is no need to have an update for the Commission in the mid-term report.
- The plan is to have a good draft of a strategic plan for the November Expanded PAC meeting in the fall.
- This plan will have to grow over time with the IEC members in a position to share it with various constituency groups so that when it does come to PAC many eyes will have seen it.
