	Parking lot speed limits & cameras – Risk Management received a hazard report from a student regarding speed limits in all parking lots and having cameras in the parking lots. The report stems from an incident that occurred with the student almost 2 years ago when she states she was struck by a vehicle as she was walking through the parking lot. This continues to be a concern and issue regarding several factors. One being that students are not paying attention and walk in areas that are not visible between cars. It was suggested that working with Student Life and the Student association on a "LOOK UP" type of campaign could possible help make students aware of their surroundings.

Employees do have access to the EASE program. Duetta did mention to the committee that the EASE program has been brought up in the Wellness Committee meeting that she co- chairs and discussion has taken place regarding possibly having an onsite counselor available to staff if needed. Tim Engle was able to inform the committee that resources are being worked on in this area. A behavioral counselor/case manager is being hired.
