



Ch...ch...changes!

- 2016-17: Basic Skills, Student Equity and SSSP Programs
 - Prior to 2017 these three categorical program existed separately
- 2017-18: Integrated Plan merged three programs
 - Intent to connect and weave equity and success efforts on campus
- 2018-19: Student Equity and Achievement Program created
 - Legislation finally pulled the programs into one bucket of funding
- Result?
 - Program guidelines and reporting deadlines/requirements have changed several times!



Why a SEA Annual Report?

- 1. Satisfy legislative requirements (EDC § 78222)
- 2. Inform about efforts/progress related to equity and student success
 - CO to understand successes and challenges, provide support as needed
- 3. SEA Program expenditure management/reporting



What are the legislative requirements?

- Student Equity and Achievement Program EDC § 78222
 - Colleges/districts required to report to CO annually (by January):
 - 1. "how funding was expended in the prior fiscal year and for what specific purposes...
 - 2. include an assessment of the progress in advancing the goals (Guided Pathways, completion goals, AB705)"
 - CO required to submit legislative report summarizing the above annually (by April)



Stakeholder Input

- The SEA Workgroup includes:
 - Equity region representatives
 - Deans, Directors, Coordinators, Supervisors, Vice Presidents, Vice Chancellors, Assistant Superintendents, from the following areas/departments:
 - Student Equity, Student Success, Support Services, Counseling/Assessment, Institutional Effectiveness, Continuing Education, Matriculation, Enrollment Management, Administrative Services, Academic Senate
- An annual report subgroup drafted a template and recommendations to inform the design of the NOVA module
- The SEA workgroup also beta tested this new module THANK YOU!!



Subgroup Report Recommendations

- Previously populated data/metrics/goals should be pulled into the new NOVA module – reduce data entry
- Data should be standardized for data consolidation/reporting
- Align with Vision Goals, Guided Pathways, AB 705 and SEA goals
- Include reporting on DI groups
- Reporting expenditures of actual funds by state budget categories, and percentage of funds distributed by activity/initiative



Challenge #1: Amount of data/size of report

- Goal to keep it streamlined and fairly simple
- Pull from info that is already in NOVA/less data entry
- Less narratives/more data standardization
- What could we use for the "progress" part of the report??



Transitions and Overlap

Fiscal Year	Program/Plan	Spending Period	Report
2017-2018	Integrated Plan	7/1/17-6/30/19	September 2019
2018-2019	SEA Program	7/1/18-6/30/20	January 2020
2019-2022	Student Equity Plan	n/a	n/a
2019-2020	SEA Program	7/1/19-6/30/21	January 2021

- Transition year Integrated Plan done; new Equity Plan just entered
- Cannot wait and report on 2019-20 equity efforts report due in January
- Student Equity Plan key component of SEA Program
- There is no Student Equity Plan "report" on progress/outcomes



Tell Your Story!

- Focus on the data in the student equity plans
 - At this time, colleges will report on activities related to DI groups
 - Colleges will NOT be reporting outcomes for equity goals
 - Colleges will choose the equity plan activities/DI groups to report on
- Colleges will categorize and apply a progress measurement to each activity
 - No expectation that all of your activities are fully implemented!
- Ability to provide more detail/success stories/request support



Challenge #2: Timing of the report

- Two years to spend funds 24 months
- Colleges spend funds out of two fiscal years at any given time
- Programs have two fiscal report deadlines
 - Mid-term expenditure reporting at 12 months
 - Final expenditures due sometime after 24 months
- SEA Annual Report due each year at 18 months
- We did NOT want you to complete three SEA reports per year



Program		Required Reports	
Integrated Plan	Mid-term expenditure report Report any funds that will not be used; CO will re-allocate funds		Term-end expenditure report Report all expenditures by budget line item
SEA Program	Mid-term expenditure report	Papart expanditures for activities	Penort all expenditures by budget
SEA Program		Annual report Report expenditures for prior FY, AND any funds that will not be used and progress on activities	Term-end expenditure report Report all expenditures by budget line item




18-19 SEA Report Timeline



- Annual report will be a Year 1 (July 1, 2018-June 30, 2019) report of spending by budget item
- Will also serve as a SEA mid-term expenditure report
 - Chancellor's Office will reallocate any funds you do not plan on spending
- SEA term-end expenditure report will simple and based on the mid-term reported amounts



SEA Program Timeline




That was a lot of information! Here's what you need to know/remember for now

- The SEA Annual Report has two MAIN components:
 - 1. Expenditures 18-19 SEA YEAR 1 (July 1, 2018 June 30, 2019)
 - Let us know what you've spent so far, and still plan to spend
 - 2. Progress on activities from 19-22 Student Equity Plan
- The Annual Report is due January 1, 2020
- The 18-19 SEA term-end expenditure report is due Sept 2020
- There is no separate Student Equity Plan report









NOVA Module Walk-through



Ready, Set.... Go!

- SEA Annual Report module is live but beta testing is occurring
- Will be ready for data entry in mid-October
 - Announcement will be posted to SEA listserv
- Certification required by January 1, 2020
 - Reminders sent through NOVA and listserv as deadline approaches

- FAQs document will be created based on training sessions

Title	Contents	Due Date			
SEA Annual Report	Prior year expenditures, progress on activities serves as a mid-term expenditure report	Due January 1 annually			
SEA Term-End Report	Full two-years of expenditures	Due September 15 annually			
2019-2022 Student Equity Plan	Goals and activities related to overall population and DI groups	Due June 30 every 3 years (next due in 2022)
