	Committee is promoting and educating the campus about the ZTC and
	Low Cost designations/icons. <u>LIEAL</u> (Library Initiative for Equitable &
	Affordable Learning) is taking the lead for the campus with this work.
	We recommended that LIEAL be provided with ongoing funding to
	support the work they have started.

- 3. Adoption of more affordable learning materials: The Committee recommended the creation of a new icon for low cost textbook designation (<\$40). We are now working with Instruction Office to add it to the schedule of classes. A FAQ about Zero Cost and Low Cost Designations was written to provide clarity to the designations for the campus. The Committee also wrote the Textbook Adoption Roadmap to support the adoption of affordable learning materials and the promotion of OER adoption.</p>
- 4. Support best practices for OER and shared resources: The Committee wrote <u>Recommendations for Adoption of Required Instructional</u> <u>Materials</u> to help faculty to minimize costs of instructional materials for students.
