During these meetings, they were working on adding the low cost/no cost icon on the schedule, which is now up and running. Students can filter the schedule of classes, search for low-cost materials and collaborated with Associated Students. They voted on \$40 being the low cost threshold. 3.0	Review Textbook and Materials Committee Purpose and Function Statement and 2022- 23 Committee Goals and Progress Report	Monika shared that the TIMC goals remained the same as last year.  Purpose and Function Statement:  4. Keep up on current trends and scholarship in OER adoption, textbook and instructional materials, affordability, availability, format, accessibility, and copyright compliance. Recommend and advocate for resources and POD training to educate faculty and staff on ways to effectively implement and address related issues.  Membership: Monika shared that next year, many faculty will be rolling off. Unless the meeting time changes, Monika will be the only faculty member on the committee.  Monika will update the terms for each appointment and send back to Maridelle. She will also reach out to Roger about faculty appointments. May need to look at the vacant EOPS, CARE, CalWORKs appointments. The committee has not been able to fill it since 2021. It may need to change to a regular faculty. 4.0	AP 4225 Course Repetition and Withdrawals & AP 5075 Course Adds and Drops – (Francisco and George)	Francisco shared that AP 4225 was looked at in the Spring of 2022 and submitted through the governance process. AP 4225 was approved at SPEAC and then Academic Senate. It stopped at AMAC in June 2022.  There was language added to AP 4225 on grade alleviation.  Grade alleviation would allow for a student's bad mark not to be included in the calculation of the GPA.	George will lead a task group on updating AP 5075. 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		Grade alleviation will not necessarily remove the grade, but it will remove it from the calculation. This allows students to weigh GPAs as they go into the admissions process.  The form for grade alleviation has not been created. A workgroup will be formed to create the form.  Since AP 4225 stalled last Spring, the implementation and creating of a form has not happened.  Maridelle will reach out to Council members to collect volunteers who would like to be on the workgroup.  Individuals who will be in the workgroup will be those who have participated in grade alleviation (Lupita, George, Francisco, Sara, Bernie).
