8.0	CCSSE 2019 Executive Summary of Results presentation (Barbara McNeice-Stallard; Annel Tagarao)	The Community College Survey of Student Engagement (CCSSE) was administered in the Spring of 2019 for credit students who are 18 years of age or older only. The survey is long. It helps us to identify areas (to both celebrate and improve) related to student engagement.  Barbara reviewed the "Highest and Lowest Aspects of Student Engagement."  Our highest areas, in comparison to the total CCSSE cohort, are active:  • Made a class presentation • Worked with classmates outside of class to prepare assignments • Frequency: career counseling (2 or more times) • Frequency: peer or other tutoring (5 or more times) • Frequency: skill labs (writing, math, etc.) (5 or more times)  The comparison is to the average benchmark scores from the top 10% of the current 3-year cohort. AND, although our percentages are higher, they still may be lower than our own standards are.  Our lower areas are:  • Asked questions in class or contributed to class discussions • Came to class without completing readings or assignments • Talked about career plans with an instructor or advisor (often or very often) • Frequency: academic advising/planning (2 or more times)	Barbara has presented at IEC, Accreditation Steering Committee and Guided Pathways workgroup. She volunteered to return to continue this review and discussion, which would include results from the Faculty Predictions Exercise.  Several committee members would like to see all the data (responses) for each item.  Maridelle will send an e-copy of the CCSSE 2019 Executive Summary to Council members who can share with others.
