



Donut 'Stark Saturn' White Peach

Also called *Saucer* or *Peento Peach*. Unique white-fleshed fruit with a sunken center (shaped like a doughnut). Low in acidity, sweet, with mild almond overtones. The tiny pit doesn't cling to the white flesh — easily pops out with thumb. Fruit's thin red skin has little or no fuzz and does not have to be peeled. Vigorous and resistant to bacterial leaf spot. Self-fruitful. Harvest June-July.
