# Honors Program

## Admission Requirements

If your Mt. SAC bachelor-level GPA is higher than or equal to a 3.2, you may apply to the Honors Program by submitting the following documents:

- A. A copy of your most recent transcript and a Work in Progress form for any classes whose grades are not final. You must have at least 9 units of transferable coursework completed and show documentation of eligibility for English 1A. This requirement may not be waived.
- B. Letter of recommendation from a professor or teacher commenting on your character, scholarly commitment and academic strengths.
- C. A brief essay (300-500 words) which addresses the following questions:
  - 1. Describe any challenges or circumstances that you believe have interfered with your academic achievement.
  - 2. What impact have these challenges/circumstances had on you as a student? As a person?
  - 3. How has your situation changed in a way that would enable you to be academically successful if admitted to the Honors Program?

If your grade point average is above 3.5, the letter of recommendation and essay requirements are waived. You must still be eligible for English 1A and have completed at least 9 units of transferable coursework to be eligible for the Honors Program

**All Honors students must attend an Honors Orientation meeting before they can enroll in Honors classes.**
