

# LEAD Completors Outcome Report 2013-2023

The Leadership Education and Development (LEAD) Program is a non-credit certificate program dedicated to developing students to become effective leaders. Participants receive a co-curricular leadership certificate upon completion of the required workshops in personal and/or organizational leadership.

#### **Summary Results**

- The mean or average overall GPA of LEAD Completors was 3.43.
- 59% of the LEAD Certificate Completors identified as female.
- 65% of the LEAD Certificate completors were under 26 years of age when they completed.
- 74% of the LEAD Completors have earned either a certificate or a degree from Mt. SAC.
- 38% of the LEAD Completors have received Bachelor's degrees.



Beginning in spring 2017 through Fall 2023, 178 students have earned at least one LEAD certificate. 76% of these students have earned both the Organizational and Personal certificates.



More than half of the LEAD completors identified as female (59%). 40% identified as male. The gender of two students is unknown.




The starting term GPA of students as they began their first LEAD certificate was compared to their term GPA of the term they completed their first LEAD certificate. 20% of the students had higher term GPAs at their completing term, 56% had the same GPA, and 25% had a lower term GPA.

## **Students**




74% or 116 of the students completing a LEAD certificate earned either or both an associates degree or a certificate at Mt. SAC. Most of the students awarded Mt. SAC degrees or certificates did so after they earned their LEAD certificate(s). Slightly more of the Organizational Certificate completors earned Mt. SAC awards than those completing the Personal Certificate. Over 70% of all students earned a Mt. SAC award after completing their LEAD Certificate.

Organizational Certificate completors earned 131 certificates and 219 associates degrees at Mt. SAC. Personal Certificate completors earned 118 certificates and 213 associates degrees at Mt. SAC. More than half of these awards were granted after completing their LEAD certificate program, over 64% of the certificates and over 85% of the associates degrees were completed after their LEAD Certificate was earned. In total students completing at least one LEAD certificate earned 135 Mt. SAC certificates and 237 associates degrees.
