

Top 10 Things to Know about the Workshops & Tours

- 1 There are fewer workshops & tours offered in summer due to the 6 week session and reduced open hours. If you need to attend 2 or more workshops, you will probably need to start at the beginning of the summer in order to fit them into your schedule. Check your schedule early to be sure.
- 2 Signing up online guarantees you a spot in the workshop or tour. Sign up at <http://mtsac.libguides.com/workshops>. You'll see a link to the sign up form on the right side of the page.
- 3 Workshops are held in room 238 in the Library.
- 4 Tours start at the Information Desk in the Library.
- 5 To receive proof of completion, students must participate and complete the activities.
- 6 Students who miss more than 15 minutes of the workshop may not receive proof of completion.
- 7 Bring your research assignment prompt with you if you have one. You will have time to research your own topics in most workshops.

Developing Research Topics, 75 min Learn how to search reliable reference sources for overviews, narrow and broaden research topics, and develop focused research topics. Bring your assignment prompt if you have one. This workshop is most useful in the early stages of your research assignment.	
Evaluating Websites, 75 min Learn how to evaluate websites.	
Finding and Evaluating Articles, 75 min Learn how to select and search library article databases, distinguish between popular and scholarly periodical literature, evaluate articles, and troubleshoot your searches. (Also available online. See http://mtsac.libguides.com/workshops/online .)	
Finding and Evaluating Books, 75 min Learn how to find and evaluate books for academic research, locate books online and in the library, and troubleshoot your searches. (Will also be available online soon. See http://mtsac.libguides.com/workshops/online .)	
Library Tour, 30 min Learn about helpful resources like group study rooms, reserved textbooks, research workshops, 24/7 online chat help, books & audiobooks, computers & printing, and many other supportive services and policies.
