Students who complete the program usually enter with at least a 2.8 GPA.</p> <p>It is strongly recommended that general education requirements for the Associate in Science Degree be satisfied prior to enrolling in the program.</p> <p>Admission to the program is competitive. Selection is based upon a combination of test scores, academic work completed, and grades earned.
