No upper division credit)</p> <p>Note: For transfer students who have completed an approved Alcohol & Drugs (CAADE accredited program) or Eating Disorder Certificate Program at local community colleges, the CSU Fullerton Human Services program will accept up to 18 units of transfer credit for majors in the program. Students must show evidence of having completed the certificate program before transfer credit will be accepted.
