

VETERINARY LABORATORY TECHNICIAN - ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY

This position supports in-vivo testing of medical devices to meet R&D and regulatory requirements. The individual will serve as an animal surgical technician in a vivarium environment.

RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE:

- Anesthesia induction, intra-operative monitoring, and surgical recovery.
- Accurately documenting activities and recording data in a GLP environment.
- Assisting with surgical procedures in sterile and non-sterile surgical suites and cath labs.
- Using, calibrating, and maintaining laboratory equipment.
- Cleaning and sterilizing surgical instruments and packs.
- Cleaning and setting up procedure rooms, ORs, and cath labs.
- Performing inventory, ordering supplies, and maintaining logbooks.
- Communicating with management and coworkers to report issues and develop solutions.
- Assisting with facilities or animal husbandry tasks as needed.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- A high school diploma is required. A bachelor's degree is preferred.
- Must have hands-on experience with animals.
- Ability to operate a variety of laboratory equipment (anesthesia machines, blood analyzers, etc).
- Understanding of good documentation practices.
- Understanding of sterile technique.
- Appreciation for organization and cleanliness.
- Effective communication skills, both oral and written.
- Ability to work both independently and as a member of a team.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Experience in a GLP environment.

- Experience with swine and ruminants.
- Experience in an interventional radiology environment (cath lab).
- Education or experience as a veterinary technician in biomedical research or private practice is highly desired.
- AALAS Certification preferred.
- Additional Factors / Environmental Tolerances:
- Will require working with human and animal blood and/or tissues.
- 100% of time will be spent in a laboratory environment.
- Heavy lifting and standing for long periods of time.
