What we are discussing and solving in the meeting:

We need to make sure that the outcomes of teaching the intro class ANIM 130, and the intermediate class ANIM 132, are uniform no matter which faculty teaches the classes. In the past, a problem has been that students are not adequately prepared to begin ANIM 132, as outcomes are not as effectively defined for adjunct professors.

So we would be meeting for 2 hours, to work out the teaching plans, and mapping them to the outcome needed. These would include the various techniques taught in the intro class, and how it blends into the more advanced methods of the next class. We also are looking to eliminate redundancy between the classes, while staying true to the official curriculum.

I would like to ascertain that the outcomes are clear, and predictable, and very explainable to any professor.
