Coordinated with the Japanese and Korean professors to create language specific Language Partners. Fall 2019 (prepandemic), 148 Japanese students completed generic Language Partner Activities. In fall 2021 (post-pandemic shut down), 237 Japanese students completed textbook specific Language Partner Activities. This 220% increase in participation has led to creating Korean-textbook specific Language Partner Activities.

- a) Rosetta Stone learning hours decreased 19% in 2021 from 2020 because as classes returned to campus, they could make different assignments.
- b) GoReact video recordings grew by just over 7% from 2020 to 2021.
- c) Lingco Language Lab licenses used increased by 35% as more professors started using it.
- d) VoiceThread licenses used increased by 11%. (05/13/2022)
