One of the largest community colleges in California, Mt. San Antonio College serves nearly 20 local communities and has educated more than 1.2-million people since opening in 1946. The college has the honor of being federally designated as a Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI) and an Asian American and Native American Pacific Islander Serving Institution (AANAPISI).



Wide-ranging Academic Programs

Mt. SAC academic programs are widely recognized with programs earning recognition at regional, state, national and international competitions.

- 379 degrees and certificate programs
- 2,210 associate degrees awarded in 2021
- 1,785 associate degree for transfers awarded in 2021
- 1,064 certificates awarded in 2021



Transfers to Four-Years

Mt. SAC is consistently listed among the Top 10 colleges in the state that transfers students to 4-year institutions.

- 2,532 students transferred to four-year institutions
- 558 students transferred to UC campuses
- 1,396 students transferred to CSU campuses
- 233 students transferred to private colleges and universities



Training the Workforce

Mt. SAC is one of largest workforce training providers in California. It is a leader in economic development and vocational training because of partnerships with local industries, community-based organizations, and professional associations. Popular careers include:
